To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, CLYDE M. DAVIS, a citizen of the United States, residing at the city of Kalamazoo, in the county of Kalamazoo, State of Michigan, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Sign.

My new, original and ornamental design for a sign is clearly illustrated in the accompanying drawing, consisting of a cylindrical cigar-shaped body, having spiral

seams representing the edges of the wrapper leaf outlined by lenses, and characters on its side outlined by lenses, and a tip portion having a plurality of lenses thereon.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a sign substantially as shown and described.
