A BILL

Providing for a life-size marble statue of the late Senator Edward Dickinson Baker from the marble model in possession of the family of the deceased Senator.

- 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
- 2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
- 3 That the sum of ten thousand dollars be, and is hereby,
- 4 appropriated, from any moneys in the Treasury not other-
- 5 wise appropriated, to procure, to be placed in the Capitol, a
- 6 life-size marble statue of the late Senator Edward Dickinson
- 7 Baker from the marble model for such statue now in the
- 8 possession of the family of the deceased Senator; and the
- 9 *Librarian of Congress* ~~Joint Committee on the Library~~ is hereby authorized and
- 10 *make a contract with Horatio Stone to* directed to carry out the provisions of this act.
