AN ACT

Providing for a life-size marble statue of the late Senator Edward
Dickinson Baker.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the sum of ten thousand dollars be, and is hereby,
4 appropriated, from any moneys in the Treasury not other-
5 wise appropriated, to procure, to be placed in the Capitol, a
6 life-size marble statue of the late Senator Edward Dickinson
7 Baker from the marble model for such statue now in the
8 possession of the family of the deceased Senator; and the
9 Librarian of Congress is hereby authorized and directed to
10 make a contract with Horatio Stone to carry out the provis-
11 ions of this act.
