and referred to the Committee on Rules and Administration

JOINT RESOLUTION

To provide for placing a suitable plaque on the base of the statue
of Edward Dickinson Baker in the rotunda of the Capitol.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the Architect of the Capitol, with the approval of the
4 Joint Committee on the Library, is hereby authorized and
5 directed to procure and cause to be affixed to the base of
6 the statue of Edward Dickinson Baker, located in the rotunda
7 of the Capitol, a suitable plaque bearing appropriate refer-
8 ences to the life and achievements of the said Edward Dickin-
9 son Baker.

10 SEC. 2. There is hereby authorized to be appropriated
11 such sum as may be necessary to carry out the provisions
12 of this joint resolution.
