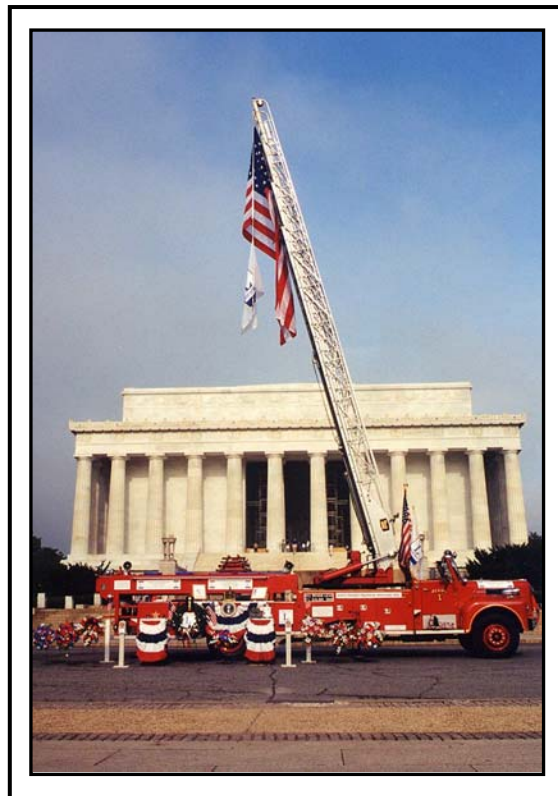

Millennium Tour - 2000

Started July 29, 2000 at Lincoln Memorial
then on to Times Square and Parts West to
Commemorate 1915 "Film & Flag Trip" of Lincoln Highway Association.

Goal is Fourfold:

- 1. Carry "Sacred Fire of Liberty" Across Nation.*
- 2. Stop in Every Town on The Lincoln Highway
Raise the American and Lincoln Highway Flag on 100' Ladder.*
- 3. Get 5 Million People to "Put in Their Two Cents"
to build the World's Largest Penny Statue of Mr. Lincoln.*
- 4. Meet with Civic Leaders Encourage them to
Nominate their Portion of Highway for
White House Community Millennium Trail Designation.*

Museum is Largest Sponsor in the White House Program.

Have Visited 88 of 450 Towns so Far.

Beginning again on July 29, 2001.

Over 300 towns across America held Bon Fire Celebrations.

"All Roads Lead to Galion, Ohio"

In 1917, The Galion Iron Works & Manufacturing Company
Produced 47 Different Kinds of Road Building Equipment
That Helped Build The Lincoln Highway and America's Blossoming Road System.
They were One of the World's Largest Producers of Road Building Equipment.
Won the Gold Medal for their "Premier Road Grader" at the 1915 Panama-Pacific Exposition.
They also made Enamel Road Sign ...One Being
"All Roads Lead to Galion, Ohio"

The Galion Commercial Club.
The Rev. A.E. I. Boss was called upon
to Characterize the Qualities of
Abraham Lincoln.
